

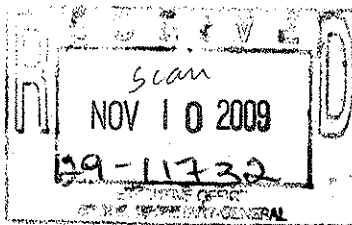

Dear Secretary General,

I have the honor to invite you to a **High Level United Nations Conference on the South-South Cooperation** to be held in Nairobi, Kenya, from **1st to 3rd December 2009**.
